### Transit Delays Expected

**Florida Operations:** Both Miami and Winter Haven's power has been restored. However, many customers are still closed due to power.

**Miami, FL** - Miami is fully operational. We are communicating with our customers in Miami area to pick up and deliver to those that are available.

**Winter Haven, FL** - Inbound freight from Atlanta is in route back to Winter Haven. With evacuation traffic headed back into Florida that process will be slower than normal. Due to the amount of inbound freight in house pickups will be very limited the remainder of this week. We are communicating with our customers in the Winter Haven area to deliver to those that are available.

**Atlanta, GA** - Atlanta is fully operational. We anticipate there will be delays as we work to reappoint freight that was due to deliver earlier this week.
